### Synopsis

A loyal friend, a good family, a residential area in a distinguished Catalan town... Everything seems to run smooth in the life of Ímogen Valeiro, a thirteen-year-old teenager. Nevertheless, she keeps a secret so deep inside that, due to a mind trick, even she is blinded to it, until one day this secret —a traumatic past anecdote— refuses to remain in the dark any longer. Then, it starts revealing itself little by little in the shape of a bad dream tightly related with her neighbour Ricard Prats, whose simple presence provokes an involuntary intense feeling of mistrust. Extremely observant and sagacious, Ímogen starts to suspect Ricard's lewd behaviour towards young girls, and so self-imposes a weighty mission: to unmask him before the citizens of Alella.

Unluckily, her persistent nightmares alter her night cycle so deeply that she falls ill because of sleep deprivation; in chain succession, this psychic disorder brings another and this, in its turn, a third one, until she gives in completely to her fears and will make catastrophic mistakes.

Mistakes punished by justice.

A look at the fine line which separates a comfortable life from a tragedy.

An apology to friendship, for one of the protagonist's main objectives is to protect the naïve Clara Vázquez from Ricard's lust; Clara, at the same time, will stand by Ímogen in all the steps she takes, regardless of the risk.
